HAD ENOUGH?

How many times during the course of our lives have we said: “I’ve had enough, I’m done!” For most of us, that comment is made in moments of extreme exasperation. In Saint Matthew’s gospel for the 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Peter tells Jesus that he is willing to forgive a brother seven times if that brother sins against him. Imagine Peter’s surprise when the Lord answers back: “Not seven times...but seventy-seven times!” In other words, Jesus is telling Peter that his ability to forgive others must be unlimited, even when he might feel like he’s “had enough.” This is definitely “food for thought” for all of us when we examine how we’re doing on the forgiveness score!
