*ATTENTION ST. GABRIEL PARISHIONERS – NOTICE #2...*

Through the generosity of Saint Gabriel parishioners, after our theft recovery expenses were covered by insurance and by individual donations from parishioners, we had \$1,700.00 left over that was donated by parishioners in our Theft Recovery Fund. All items from last summer’s break-in/vandalism have been replaced. At the January 19, 2021 Finance Council meeting, council members voted to use the \$1,700.00 for some worthwhile and worthy purpose within the parish. With the permission of Theft Recovery Fund donors, I proposed that \$1000.00 be used to fund Religious Education scholarships and that \$700.00 be contributed to the Building and Maintenance Fund of our parish. My proposal met with the agreement of the Finance Council. If any Theft Recovery Fund donors object to the money being used in this way, please let me know as soon as possible. In an effort to reach all parishioners who donated to this fund, this notice will be printed for a third and final time in next Sunday’s bulletin.
