A HUMBLE EXAMPLE...

This weekend the Church celebrates the Baptism of the Lord. As Saint Luke's gospel indicates, our Lord was baptized by John the Baptist along with a sizable crowd. Because Jesus was God, He had no need of baptism. Our Lord submitted Himself to baptism simply to give us a humble example of what we must do. As you know, the Sacrament of Baptism is the gateway to the other six sacraments. We are indeed blessed and fortunate to be able to be washed in the waters of baptism so as to prepare ourselves for the life of grace that our Catholic faith provides for us.
